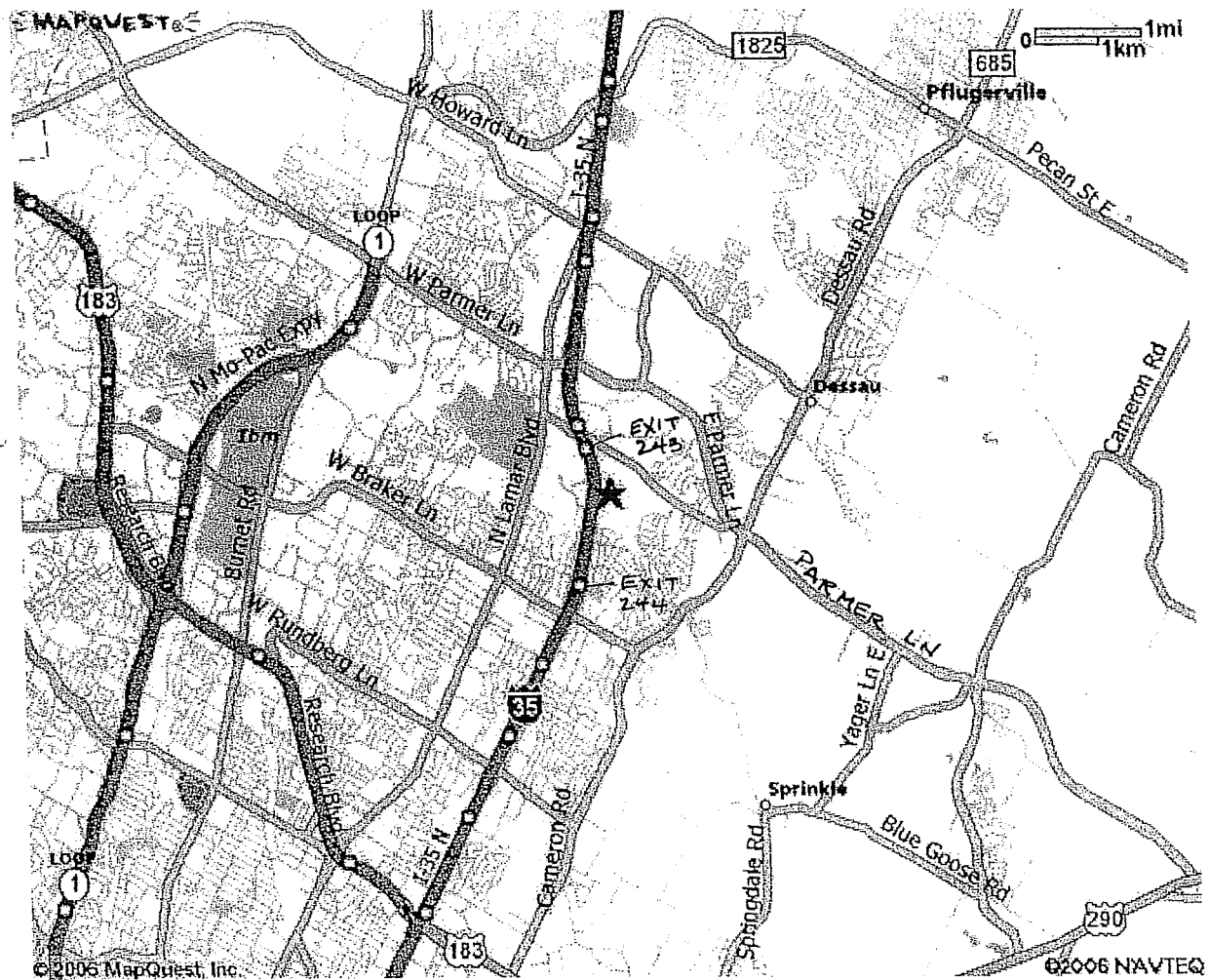

VFW POST 8787 IS LOCATED IN NORTH AUSTIN JUST OFF OF THE NORTH BOUND IH-35 SERVICE ROAD BETWEEN BRAKER AND YAGER LANE.

FROM NORTH TEXAS:  
TAKE IH 35 SOUTH TO AUSTIN, TAKE THE BRAKER LANE EXIT (EXIT 243);  
TURN LEFT AND GO ACROSS THE OVERPASS AND LEFT AGAIN TO HEAD  
NORTH ON THE SERVICE ROAD. GO APPROXIMATELY 1 1/10 MILE TO VFW  
ROAD. LOOK FOR "BEST BUY" BILLBOARD...TURN ON YOUR BLINKER.  
TURN ONTO VFW ROAD JUST PASS THIS BILLBOARD AND AT THE  
CHAINLINKED RETENTION POND.

FROM SOUTH TEXAS:  
TAKE IH 35 NORTH, TAKE THE YAGER LANE EXIT (EXIT 244); GO  
APPROXIMATELY 9/10 MILE FROM EXIT TO VFW ROAD. LOOK FOR "BEST  
BUY" BILLBOARD....TURN ON YOUR BLINKER. TURN ONTO VFW ROAD  
JUST PASS THIS BILLBOARD AND AT THE CHAINLINKED RETENTION POND.

**2007 Cook's Rules and Information**

1. A \$100.00 entry fee is required for one or all meat categories. The entry fee for all jackpot categories (beans, chili, margaritas, salsa and desserts) are \$10.00 each with 80% payback in three places.
2. **IBCA** rules will apply in all BBQ categories and Jackpot Beans. Brisket, Spare Ribs and Chicken only will count toward Grand and Reserve Champion. Only one entry per pit.
3. Cook's Choice is anything, other than desserts, cooked on the Pit. Saturday turn-in. **Not** counted towards Grand or Reserve Champion.
4. Beans are dry pinto only cooked on sight. Nothing larger than the bean to be turned in. Saturday turn-in.
5. Chili is jackpot and/or wild. No rules. Just you're best tasting bowl of red. Saturday turn-in.
6. Margaritas can be frozen or on the rocks. Judges will have salt and limes. Friday night turn-in.
7. The hot sauce or salsa category is the stuff you serve with chips for dipping. It can be any color. The judges will be looking for the best tasting salsa. Friday night turn-in.
8. Desserts are wide open. No rules. Friday night turn-in.
9. Teams will consist of a Head Cook and no more than four team members please.
10. Electricity – first come, first serve. It is only designed to handle lights, radios, electric knives, etc. – Not A/C units, heaters, microwaves, etc.
11. Water – we have water available within walking distance of all spaces. Please share. Please do not hook-up a hose directly to the spigot unless you provide a "Y" spigot to share the water with your neighbors.
12. Registration will start at 10:00 a.m. Friday inside the North Door of Hall 2 inside the VFW Post.
13. All meat must be cooked from scratch and is subject to inspection before starting. No pre-cooking, pre-marinating, dry rubs, etc. will be allowed. All meats will be cooked on site.

14. All Head Cooks must attend Cook's Meeting at 8:30 a.m. Saturday.
15. Turn-in trays and cups will be handed out Friday night at 6:00 p.m. for those cooks already registered and in attendance. All others may be picked up Saturday morning after the cook's meeting.
16. Turn-in cups and trays for Friday night jackpots will be given out upon entering. (Margaritas, salsa and desserts only).
17. The double ticket blind judging system will be used for all categories.
18. We will hold a Calcutta on Friday night at 7:00 p.m.
19. Due to our liquor license ---- **PLEASE, NO DRINKS OF ANY KIND CAN BE BROUGHT IN OR TAKEN OUT OF THE BUILDING!!!** You are welcome to drink and party, but please don't cross a threshold with an open container. Thank You in advance for your cooperation on this one!!!
20. Fires must be of wood, wood substance or charcoal. No electric or gas grills. Fires may not be built on the ground. No holes or open pits allowed. Please use grease containers. Each team will be responsible for the clean up of their space.
21. Turn-In Times will be handed to you when you register.
22. Free Spaghetti dinner to all cooks Friday night at 6:00 p.m. Karaoke both Friday and Saturday night. Pancake breakfast for donations on Saturday morning by Boy Scout Troop 8787.
23. Sandwiches will be available by the Ladies Auxiliary on Friday during lunch time.
24. The Head Cook will be responsible for the conduct and actions of his team. Excessive use of alcohol will be grounds for disqualification. Quiet time is midnight Friday till 5:00 a.m. Saturday. Please respect your neighbors.
25. For everyone's safety, please consider spending the night again on Saturday night if you indulge in any kind of alcohol during the day. **Please don't drink and drive!**
