Rules for Cook-off

1. NOTE: Only one (1) team per (15 x 20) pit. Pits will be located on North 1st street between Cedar and Hickory Street in downtown Abilene, TX.
2. Teams will consist of a Head Cook and 2-4 members.
3. Any and all meat and/or meats that may be entered into judging will be cooked from scratch within the constraints of the event. Pre-cooking, marinating, etc., will not be allowed prior to start of the cook-off.
4. Fires must be wood or charcoal. Holes or open pits are not permitted. Fires may not be built on the ground. **Each team MUST bring a fire extinguisher.**
5. Props, trailers, motor home vehicles, tents and any other equipment may not exceed the boundary of the contestant's assigned space. No tent stakes can be driven into the asphalt.
6. Cook's meeting will be held **8:00pm, April 13th 2007** in the judging area. **HEAD COOKS MUST ATTEND.** Complete and updated rules and schedule will be distributed.
7. It is the responsibility of the contestant to see that the contest area is kept clean. Please follow all Health Department rules for cleanliness, food preparation and cooking. All fires must be put out, concrete blocks and other building materials or props hauled away and all equipment removed from the site.
8. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualification. Alcoholic beverages must be poured into cups for consumption. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public by contestants. No food sales or samples to be given to the general public.
9. The APL, officials, and promoters are not responsible for accidents, theft or mishaps.
10. IBCA judging rules will apply.

**Check in will be 3:00p - 5:00p on Friday April 13th.
Judging will begin at 1:00p on Saturday April 14th.**

1:00 pm - Beans (any style from dry start)

1:30 pm - Dessert (your choice)

2:00 pm - 1/2 Chicken (fully jointed split chicken)

3:00 pm - Pork SPARE ribs (7 ribs with bone in)

4:00 pm - Brisket (7 slices approx 1/4" to 3/8")

Based on the number of cooks turn-in quantities are subject to change.

NO GARNISH or SAUCE is allowed in the tray at turn-in. You can cook with sauce but it cannot be ladled onto the meat at turn-in.

An updated rules and schedule will be available at the cook's meeting at **8:00pm, April 13th 2007.**

Awards Ceremony will be held 6:30pm on April 14th.

You must be present to accept your award.
