2007 Bubba Can Cook Sanctioned Barbeque Cook Off Rules
September 22, 2007

- Only one (1) team per pit
- Teams will consist of a Head Cook and up to 4 members
- Any and all meat and/or meats that may be entered into judging will be cooked from scratch within the constraints of the event. Pre-cooking, marinating, etc., will not be allowed prior to the start of the cook-off as defined by the cook-off promoter.
- Fire must be wood or charcoal. Pit may include gas or electricity to start the natural substances, but not to complete cooking. Holes or open pits are not permitted. Fires may not be built on the ground. Each team must bring a fire extinguisher.
- Props, trailers, motor home vehicles, tents and any other equipment may not exceed the boundary of the contestant's assigned space.
- The Chief Cook's Meeting will be on Saturday, September 22, 2007 at 7:00 a.m. in the Grimes County Go Texan building. Head cooks must attend.
 - ½ chicken Fully jointed split chicken (with breast, wing, thigh, and drumstick)
 - Pork Spare Ribs 7 individual ribs (bone in-St Louis cut acceptable)
 - Brisket 7 full slices (approx. ¼ inch – 3/8 inch thick)

Based on the number of Cooks turn-in quantities are subject to change. NO GARNISH OR SAUCE is allowed in the tray at turn in. You can cook with sauce, but it cannot be ladled onto the meat in turn-in tray. IT MUST BE COOKED ON. (Puddling will also be monitored and not allowed)

- It is the responsibility of the contestant to see that the contest area is kept clean and that the area is cleaned following the contest. All fires must be put out, concrete blocks, and other building materials or props hauled away and all equipment removed from the site.
- Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualifications. Alcoholic beverage rules must be followed. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public by contestants. No food sales to the general public.
- Only two vehicles per entry per space will be allowed in cook-off area. Motor home is considered as one (1) vehicle.
- No animals allowed in cook-off area, with exception of Seeing Eye Dogs.
- IBCA judging rules will apply.
- Promoter and cook-off officials will not be held responsible for accidents, theft, or any mishaps.
- Volume of music should be limited to each cooker's area and noise level should be minimal after 11:00 p.m. on Friday.
- Contestants may set up and check in anytime between Friday – 12:00 p.m. (noon) and 9:00 p.m. – Gates will be locked at 9:00 p.m. Friday, September 21, 2007 and will not re-open until 9:00 a.m. Saturday, September 22, 2007. No late entries accepted.
- Contestants must supply ALL NEEDED EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE COOKED ON SITE. Electrical hook-ups and water will be provided on site with covered sites.
- Completion of the entry form, including the signature of the Chief Cook on the Release of Liability with all listed members of the team. Participants agree by submission of their name on entry form to the terms of the Release of Liability. The Chief Cook will be responsible for assuring that all members of the team are aware of contest rules including the Release of Liability.
