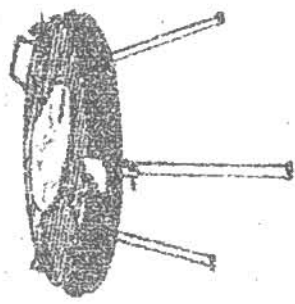

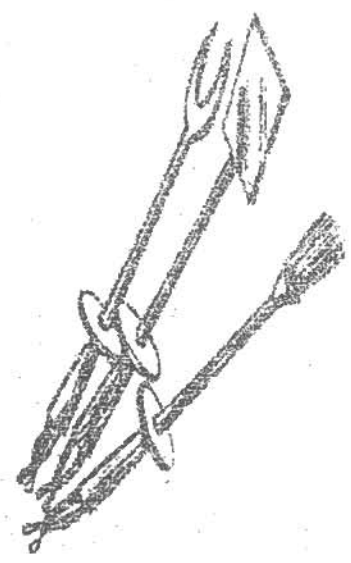

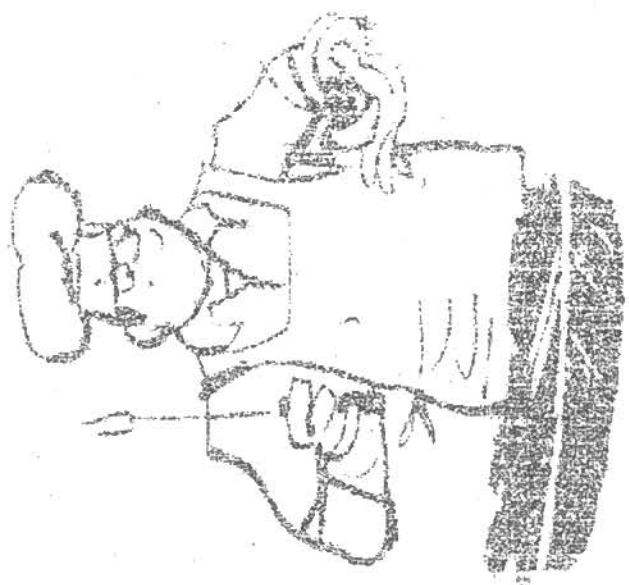

TO BENEFIT VFW POST 1839

1. **VFW Post 1839 will not be liable for any theft, damage, or accidents.**
2. **ABSOLUTELY NO FIREARMS NOR EXPLOSIVES WILL BE ALLOWED.**
3. The cooking area will be marked off: spaces are "first come , first served".
4. Contestants may begin checking in March 30, 2007 at 3p.m. The deadline for entering will be 9 a.m. March31, 2007
5. No pre-seasoning nor pre-cooking of meat is allowed until it has been inspected and approved for cook-off use. Once the meat has been inspected and approved it must not leave your contest area
6. Only one entry(one chief cook) will cook on a given pit. Multiple entries in same category by same cook is prohibited - multiple entries from the same piece of meat is prohibited. For this event, contestants must be 18 years old or older to participate for cash prizes.
7. Chief cooks will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team and guests. The excessive use of alcoholic beverages shall be grounds for disqualification. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be sold or offered in any form to the public. No display of alcoholic beverage containers will be allowed.
8. It is the responsibility of the BBQ team to see that the contest area is kept clean and the area cleaned following the contest.
9. All fires used to prepare meat in the contest must be of wood or charcoal. No gas or electric cooking equipment will be allowed(except for bean cooking). You may use propane to start your fire. No fires on the ground, or dug pits are allowed.
10. Head cooks meeting at 9 a.m., Saturday, March 30th. Head cook must attend.
11. Excessively loud amplified music or public address systems are prohibited.
12. Decisions of the chairman and judges are final.
13. All entries must be prepared in as sanitary manner as possible.
14. All teams with more than one member will provide judges for preliminaries, if needed.

BEANS.... DRY PINTO BEANS ONLY...TURN IN....11 A.M.
CHICKEN ... 1/2 WHOLE FULLY JOINED CHICKEN ,.... TURN.... 12 P.M.
RIBS... 7 FULL RIBS, PORK SPARE RIBS ONLY-- NO BABY BACKS.. TURN IN ..1 P.M.
BRISKET..8 LB MINIMUM WEIGHT COOKED, 7 FULL SLICES, 1/4" TO 3/8" THICK..TURN IN..2
