RULES**

The 13TH annual cook-off will be held Friday May 11 and Saturday May 12, 2007

1. This year all the International Bar-B-Que Cookers Association (IBCA) Rules will apply and an IBCA representative will attend and monitor our Cook Off to make the event a IBCA sanctioned event. Rules available at <http://www.ibcabbq.org>
 2. Cooking equipment and setup will be allowed at the contest site in designated areas on Friday, May 11, 2007. Cooking spaces will be 20' X 40'.
 3. A cook-off team consists of a Chief Cook with assistants.
 4. **The Chief Cook will be held responsible for the conduct of his team and guest. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages and/or unruly conduct will be grounds for disqualification.**
 5. Cooking teams may bring their own beverages for consumption in cooking areas only. Teams will not sell or give away beverages to the general public (other than invited guests). Violation of this rule will be grounds for disqualification. Beer, wine and soft drinks will be available in the post canteen at discounted prices for cooking teams.
 6. Frank Cangelosi Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 4010 will not be responsible for accidents, personal injury, theft or damage to equipment.
 7. Each team will be responsible for cleanup within their assigned space.
 8. All measures will be taken to ensure that judges do not know whose entry is being judged.
 9. There will be no pre-cooked, pre-seasoned or pre-marinated entries allowed in the contest.
 10. Pre-mixed chili packets such as Wick Fowlers are not allowed.
 11. A cook-off committee member will inspect all entries prior to cooking. Cooking may begin after 3:00 p.m. Friday May 11, 2007. Make sure your entries have been checked of the control sheet.
 12. All BBQ entries must be cooked on wood or charcoal. No electric or gas fires will be allowed. Holes or dug pits will not be permitted. Gas or propane stoves will be allowed for culinary events only. All cook-off entries must be cooked on site.
 13. Judging will be based on aroma, tenderness, color and taste. Chief Cooks or a representative are required to attend meetings at 6:45 p.m. Friday and 8:30 a.m. Saturday.
 14. BBQ sauce may be used as glaze only. No Sauce will be allowed in the turn-in containers.
 15. **Turn -in containers and entries will be free of any and all identifying items or marks such as foil, garnish, etc. Violation will be grounds for disqualification.**
 16. VFW Post 4010 will provide cooking spaces only. Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies.
 17. The IBCA representative, Cook-Off Committee Chairman and Committee Members reserve the right to interpret rules and regulations of this event. Decisions of the IBCA representative, Chairman and Members are to be considered final.
 18. Entry fees will be applied to purchase trophies, plaques and cash for this event. Cash prizes of \$300, \$200, \$100 for the first, second, and third place finishers overall. Individual categories top three finishers will receive trophies only.
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
