Chief Cook is responsible for the conduct of their team members and guests.

Cooks meeting at 9:00 a.m. on April 26th in bingo hall.

Each team's space and surrounding area must be kept clean.

Water and electricity are available.

Absolutely NO FIREARMS allowed on premises.

THE ONLY THING YOU MAY ALLOW A MALE TO DO FOR YOU IS START YOUR FIREBOX!! THEY MAY NOT TEND IT IN ANY OTHER WAY AT ANY TIME.

FIVE DIVISIONS:

Bloody Mary -No Celery or Olives in turn in cup

Beans: Nothing larger than a bean in your Judge's cups.

Desserts : You may cook anything you want, as long as it is prepared on sight.

Pork spare Ribs: 7 Pork Spareribs - No Baby Back

Brisket: 7 slices approximately 1/4 inch thick. If too thick it will be sent back to be re-sliced.

1. No meat will be tagged.

2. All categories must be cooked on premises.

3. All fires used to prepare meats in this contest must be wood or charcoal. No electric equipment for the meat divisions will be allowed.

4. Electric equipment maybe used to prepare desserts with (Desserts only)

5. No sauces or garnish will be allowed in Judge's container.

6. Food must be prepared in a sanitary manner.

7. Chief cooks must be Twenty-one (21) years of age

8. No loud stereos or excessive use of alcohol and no fighting. Violation of the rules will be grounds for disqualification.

9. Have lots of fun and help us out.
