**Rules:**

1. Entry fee **\$135.00** per team if postmarked by April 25, 2008. Entry Fee **\$160.00** after April 25, 2008. The entry fee enters you in all categories. Teams will consist of a Head Cook and no more than 4 additional team members. No two (2) teams are allowed to cook on the same pit.
2. Categories: Beef Brisket, Pork Spare Ribs, Chicken Halves and Jackpot Beans. **No Baked Beans**
3. Jackpot Bean prize money will be winner take all. Prize amount will be determined by the total number of teams entered in the cook-off.  $\$10.00 \times$  number of teams entered = prize award.
4. Check In Time: **Friday, May 2, 2008**, 2:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
5. Meat & Health Inspection: All meat is subject to inspection **on Friday, May 2nd**.
6. No pre-cooking or pre-seasoning of meat is allowed. No pre-cooked meat will be judged.
7. No gas or electric cookers are allowed (except for beans). Fuel for cooking must be of wood or wood substance. No dug pits. Each team **MUST** bring a fire extinguisher.
8. There will be electricity and water available. There are also handicapped restrooms on site.
9. Each team is responsible for clean up. Each team must provide drip pans or diaper pit being used.
10. This cook-off will observe the **Rules and Regulations as set forth by the IBCA**. The chief cook must agree to all rules and sign for his team. The YMBL reserves the right to make or alter regulations as situation warrants. Decisions of the YMBL and the judges are **FINAL**.
11. Cooks meeting will be called at 9:00 a.m. on **Saturday, May 3, 2008**.
12. Judging begins on **Saturday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>**
  - 11:00 a.m. – Jackpot Beans
  - 12:00 p.m. – Chicken
  - 1:30 p.m. – Pork Spare Ribs
  - 3:00 p.m. – Beef BrisketAwards immediately following judging.
13. Cooks will prepare samples for judging in containers furnished by the IBCA.
14. Each team may be responsible for providing (1) one tasting judge. This person must be at least 18 years of age, must not be intoxicated and can not be the chief cook.
15. Neither the YMBL nor IBCA will not be responsible for accidents, theft or damage.
16. Pit spaces will be assigned after entry fees and applications are received. Props, trailer, motor home, vehicles, tents and other equipment may not exceed boundary of the contestant's assigned pit spaces.
17. All tent structures or canopies must be secured with water barrels. Boring or drilling of holes into concrete for spikes is prohibited.
18. Appropriate clothing must be worn at all times.
19. No firearms will be allowed. No pets or other animals will be allowed in the contest area.
20. The chief cook will be responsible for the conduct of his team.
21. Teams will be disqualified for fighting or otherwise causing any disturbance.
22. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualification. Alcoholic beverage rules must be followed. (example: poured into cups). Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public by contestants. No food sales or samples to be given to the general public. No drinking glass containers or bottles allowed. Note: State Law requires that you must be 21 years of age to consume alcohol. Anyone violating this law will be accountable for the consequences.
23. The YMBL Rodeo Competition BBQ Cook-off will go on rain or shine. "QUIET TIME" will be 1:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.
