1. Date: Friday, June 13, 2008 – Check in 10:00 am to 9:00 pm
Saturday, June 14th – Final Judging and Awarding of Prizes & Trophies
2. Entry Fee: \$100 – Brisket / Pork Spare Ribs / ½ Chicken
\$10 – Pinto Beans
\$10 – Bloody Mary

All Contestants Must Enter Brisket

3. Prizes & Trophies: \$200.00 cash to high point team

1 st Place	Brisket, Pork Spare Ribs & ½ Chicken – \$400 cash
2 nd Place	Brisket, Pork Spare Ribs & ½ Chicken – \$300 cash
3 rd Place	Brisket, Pork Spare Ribs & ½ Chicken – \$200 cash
4 th Place	Brisket, Pork Spare Ribs & ½ Chicken – \$100 cash
5 th Place	Brisket, Pork Spare Ribs & ½ Chicken – \$50 cash
6 th - 10 th Place	\$25 cash awarded in each meat category
1 st Place	Pinto Beans - \$100 cash
2 nd Place	Pinto Beans - \$75 cash

4. Inspection:
 - No pre-seasoning, pre-cooking, or marinating allowed before inspection.
 - Contestants must turn in ½ fully jointed chicken, seven (7) pork spare ribs, and seven (7) slices of brisket.
 - Dry beans will be furnished. **NO PRE-COOKED BEANS.**
5. Judging Procedures:
 - Only one (1) container of each category entered will be judged.
 - Judging will be International Barbeque Cookers Association (IBCA) rules.
 - Barbeque will be judged on aroma, color, texture, and taste overall.
 - Judging will be based on blind system to insure strict anonymity of contestant and to make certain that judges do not know whose product they are tasting.

DO NOT PUT BBQ SAUCE ON CONTEST MEAT!!!!

6. Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies.
7. Fires for contest meat must be of wood or wood substances.
8. Each team will be responsible for clean-up of assigned space.
9. The chief cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team and guest. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public.
10. The Caldwell FFA Boosters will not be liable for theft, damage, or accidents.
11. Contest committee reserves the right to make additional changes as situations warrant. Decisions of committee & judges will be final.
12. No pets or animals will be allowed into the area under any circumstance. No team golf carts or unauthorized vehicles will be allowed.
13. Special parking will be provided. No parking allowed within cook-offs grounds. Vehicle gates will be closed at 8 am Saturday, June 14th. Each team will be allowed one (1) vehicle with parking ticket to remain in contest area. No through traffic on Saturday.
14. Electricity will be available on a limited basis. The fee for electricity is \$10.00 for lights and fans, \$25 for travel trailers and motor homes and must be paid as you check-in. Water and showers are also available.
15. Ice will be available on grounds. No beer will be sold on the grounds, but feel free to bring all you want.
16. Each team will be allocated a 20' X 40' space. Double space available if requested.
17. **Chief cooks meeting 8:00 pm, Friday, June 13th.**
18. Team packets and beans will be available at check-in.
19. All equipment, vehicles, and belongings must be removed by 12 noon, Sunday, June 15th.
20. One team per pit.
