Rules and Regulations

1. Teams will consist of a chief cook and up to four assistants. Contestants may check in after 1:00 p.m. on **Friday May 2, 2008**. All Teams should be in place by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 3, 2008. No vehicles will be allowed in the cook-off area after that time. One team, on pit. NO competition meat can be put on the pits before 8:00 p.m. Friday, May 2, 2008.
2. Spaces will be marked (approximate size is 30' x 30') and will be on a first come first pick with the exception of reserved locations for major sponsors of the Lakeside BBQ Association.
3. There are three primary meat categories for the 2008 Lakeside Showdown BBQ Cook-Off: Brisket, Pork Spare Ribs, and Chicken. Open (which can be meat, seafood etc... NO DESSERTS). Desserts are in a category by itself and will be judged accordingly.
4. Inspections: **No Pre-seasoned, pre-cooking, or pre-marinating** of any entry before inspection. Contestants must turn in ½ jointed chicken, seven (7) pork spare ribs, and seven (7) slices of brisket. **MEAT INSPECTIONS @ 5PM ON FRIDAY. COOK'S MEETING @ 7PM.**
5. Judging Procedures: Only one (1) container of each category entered will be judged. Judging will be International Barbeque Cookers Association (IBCA) rules. Barbeque will be judged on aroma, color, texture, and taste. Judging will be based on the blind system (no garnishing and no markers) to ensure judges do not know whose product they are testing.

Final Judging and awarding of prizes will be on Saturday, May 3, 2008
6. Team Responsibilities: Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies. **Some electricity** will be available. **Water is available** at central locations. Teams shall keep their assigned area clean during competition as well as prior to departure. Trash pick-ups will be made throughout the cook-off area. Cooking conditions and areas are subject to inspection by the Committee or County Health Department. Unsanitary conditions are grounds for disqualification.
7. Chief Cooks responsibilities: Attend meeting at 7:00 p.m. Friday, May 2, 2008 in the judges tent (Official turn in times along with judging times will be announced and contest trays will be given out. Chief cooks are responsible for the conduct of their team and guest. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification.
8. Although some electricity will be available, Generators will be allowed only if they do not make excessive noise and a catch pan is used so no fuel is allowed to get on the ground.
9. **No Open Fires** on the ground will be allowed. Burn barrels must be 12 inches off the ground, BBQ pits and burn barrels must have catch pans underneath. All catch pans shall contain water. Contestants are responsible for all surface damage. Disposal of catch pan waste will be discussed at the cooks meeting. Each contestant must provide their own fire extinguisher for their cook-off area.
10. No pets or animals will be allowed into the area under any circumstance.
11. Any commercial or homemade trailered or untrailered, pit or smoker normally used for competitive barbeque can be used. A bbq pit may include gas or electricity for starting the combustion of wood or wood products, but NOT to complete cooking.
12. Under no circumstances will any individual (team member, guest, general public, etc.) be allowed to bring golf carts, motor vehicles, motorcycles, three or four wheelers, scooters, bicycles, skate boards, skates or any type of transportation into the cooking area during

competition except for handicapped transports, e.g. wheel chairs, electric scooters, etc., in use by handicapped individuals.

13. Music will be allowed. Volume of the music should be limited to each cook site. Music levels are to be reduced at 11:00 p.m. to a minimum. Noise complaints will be handled in the following manner: 1st Complaint – Team will be asked for voluntary compliance. 2nd Complaint – You may be asked to leave the grounds and cook-off. Violations of this rule will be cause for the whole team's disqualification.

14. No Bar-B-Que Brisket, Pork Spare Ribs, Chicken or any other product may be sold by a team at the cook site.

15. No Beer will be sold on the grounds. Although you may consume alcohol, **NO GLASS CONTAINERS ARE ALLOWED. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public.**

*****SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT*****

Live music will be at the lake on both Friday and Saturday nights.

The Lakeside Showdown BBQ Cook-Off will be sanctioned by the IBCA. IBCA rules will be followed regarding the cooking and judging of the meat entries. The Contest Committee reserves the right to make additional changes as situations warrant. Decisions of the committee and judges are final.
