All entries should be prepared and judged per IBCA standards. No meat check in or tagging. Standard entry fee \$125 for each team and includes one or all events and one campsite. The Kid's Contest is for cooks age 17 and younger, \$20 entry fee with 100% of pot going towards 1-3 places.

CAMPSITE AVAILABILITY

There are over 265 campsites in our park. Some of our campsites are full hookup, varied 30 or 50 amp. Most campsites have water and electricity and small sections are water only. Please visit our website for a map of the park. Campsite availability will be first come, first serve. One RV and pit per site plus two tents are allowed. Park rules will be distributed upon check in. This entry form entitles the team to one campsite. Additional campsites can be purchased for \$30/night. No golf carts, motorcycles or ATV's are allowed in the park. Please visit our website for additional lodging locations in the park and in Huntsville, Texas (30 minutes from campground).

MARINA VILLAGE CAMP N COOK OFFICIAL RULES

1. Cooked on site: All meats will be cooked on site. The preparation and completion of any and all meats and sauces in competition is within the confines of the cook-off site and during the time limits designated by the promoter. Meats could be subject to inspection at the discretion of the IBCA judge.
2. Sanitation: Cooks are to prepare and cook in as sanitary manner as possible. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection by judging committee. Infractions identified by the judging committee shall be immediately corrected or the cook will be subject to disqualification.
3. Entries per pit: IBCA recognizes only one entry (one chief cook) will cook on a given pit. It will be the responsibility of the promoter to monitor entries. Notwithstanding, multiple entries in the same category by the same cook and multiple entries from the same piece of meat shall not be allowed. With the exception of Junior/Kid 's competition, contestants must be 18 years of age to participate.
4. BBQ Pits: Any commercial or homemade, tailored or untailored, pit or smoker can be used. A pit may include gas or electricity for starting the combustion but NOT for complete cooking. Marina Village prohibits pits from cabin sites and must be stationed at a separate camping area recognized as the "official cook area".
5. Open Fires: Open or ground fires are prohibited in the Marina Village campground. BBQ pits permanently stationed at the campsite are for cooking purposes only. A fire extinguisher should be readily available.
6. Double Number System: The double number system will be used for meat judging during this competition. One number will be secured to the judging tray and the corresponding number presented to the head cook at check in. Any tampering with the secured and hidden number on the judging tray is subject to disqualification from the event. Winning numbers will be removed and revealed only during the final competition announcements.
7. Judging Tray: Tray will be provided for each category and team upon check in. Upon turn in, all containers shall be clean and free of any markings and the aluminum foil sheet provided shall be in place. The head cook is response for each tray and its turn in condition.
8. Judging Tray Contents: Quantities and cut of meat instructions will be provided by the head judge during official check in and head cook's meeting. All trays will be subject to inspection upon turn in. Garnishes and condiments are prohibited. Meats may be cooked with sauces or other liquids but must be removed and not applied to meat for the turn in process. No puddling in the bottom of the tray.
9. Turn In Time: Turn in times for each category will be pre-set and provided to all participants. A 10 minute window is set for each turn in time, before and after each posted entry time. Any entry received before or after the window will not be accepted.
10. Judges: Judges will be provided based on IBCA recommendations. Judging levels will be determined by the total number of entries for this event.
11. Judging Quantity: Judges will assign a score from 1-10 for each tray sampled. A predetermined number of top results from each event will be sent for final judging.
12. Announcing Winners: Winners for each category (except kids) will be announced for top 10 places plus final table. Winners will be announced by ticket number and verified by ticket presented.
13. Prizes: A Grand Champion will be announced for total final points awarded. In case of a tie, brisket, then ribs, then chicken respectively will determine the point difference for the tiebreaker.
14. Lodging: One campsite per team plus two tents are allowed. Additional campsites for a fee are available. Limited space is available in campground cabins but no pits allowed in cabin sites.
15. Security: Marina Village Resort is a private campground but has opened the park to the public for this event. A list of park rules will be distributed upon check in and the park will be patrolled by local law enforcement. Any person or team exhibiting unacceptable behavior and warning has been presented will be asked to leave the park. No refund for the event will be given.
